AJC organizes a seminar on promoting tourism services in ASEAN



ASEAN Member States: Countries with Abundant Natural Resources

Tokyo-based ASEAN-Japan Centre (AJC), an intergovernmental organization of the 10 Member States of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN)¹ and Japan, will organize a seminar on promoting tourism services trade in ASEAN from November 30 to December 1, 2017 in Hua Hin, Thailand. This is the fourth seminar of the Centre’s project on promoting services trade in ASEAN,² and will be organized with the Ministry of Tourism and Sports of Thailand.

This seminar will examine tourism services trade by four different services supply modes, degree of liberalization in each mode and policy recommendations to promote tourism services trade. Tourism services include hotels, restaurants, travel agencies, tour operators, tourists guide, and others.
