**ASEAN-Japan Centre reaches its 40th Anniversary
Fostering ASEAN-Japan relations since 1981**

The ASEAN Promotion Centre on Trade, Investment and Tourism, ASEAN-Japan Centre (AJC) for short, reached its 40th anniversary on 25 May 2021. AJC is an intergovernmental organization established in 1981. It has been promoting exports from the ASEAN Member States to Japan while revitalizing investment, tourism, as well as people-to-people exchanges between the ASEAN Member States and Japan.

AJC was established based on the “Fukuda Doctrine” announced in 1977 by the then prime minister of Japan, Mr. Takeo Fukuda. Originally opened with the founding member countries of the ASEAN (Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand) and Japan, with other five countries (Brunei Darussalam, Viet Nam, Cambodia, Lao PDR, and Myanmar) joining later on, all 10 ASEAN Member States and Japan are now the members of the Centre.

To commemorate the 40th anniversary of AJC, H.E. Dato Lim Jock Hoi, Secretary-General of ASEAN stated as follows: “Since its establishment in 1981, the Centre continues to play an important role in nurturing ASEAN-Japan relations that was founded on the “heart-to-heart” partnership enshrined in the Fukuda Doctrine. By conducting a large number of projects and activities, the Centre promoted exports, investment, tourism and people-to-people exchanges that have contributed greatly to the deepening of ASEAN-Japan relations, as well as enhancing mutual understanding and friendship amongst our peoples. For these efforts, I wish to convey ASEAN’s deep appreciation.”

In 2023, ASEAN and Japan will reach their 50th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations. AJC will continue to make efforts so as to contribute to the further development of the ASEAN-Japan partnership while responding to new issues between ASEAN and Japan.

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
